Civic Building Demolition



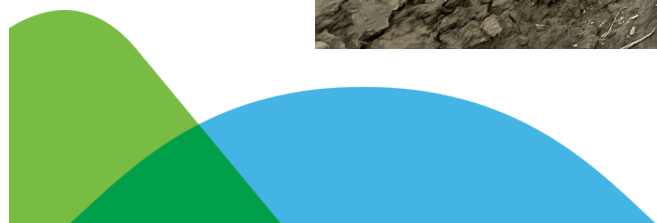
- Demolition completed

- Gym already open

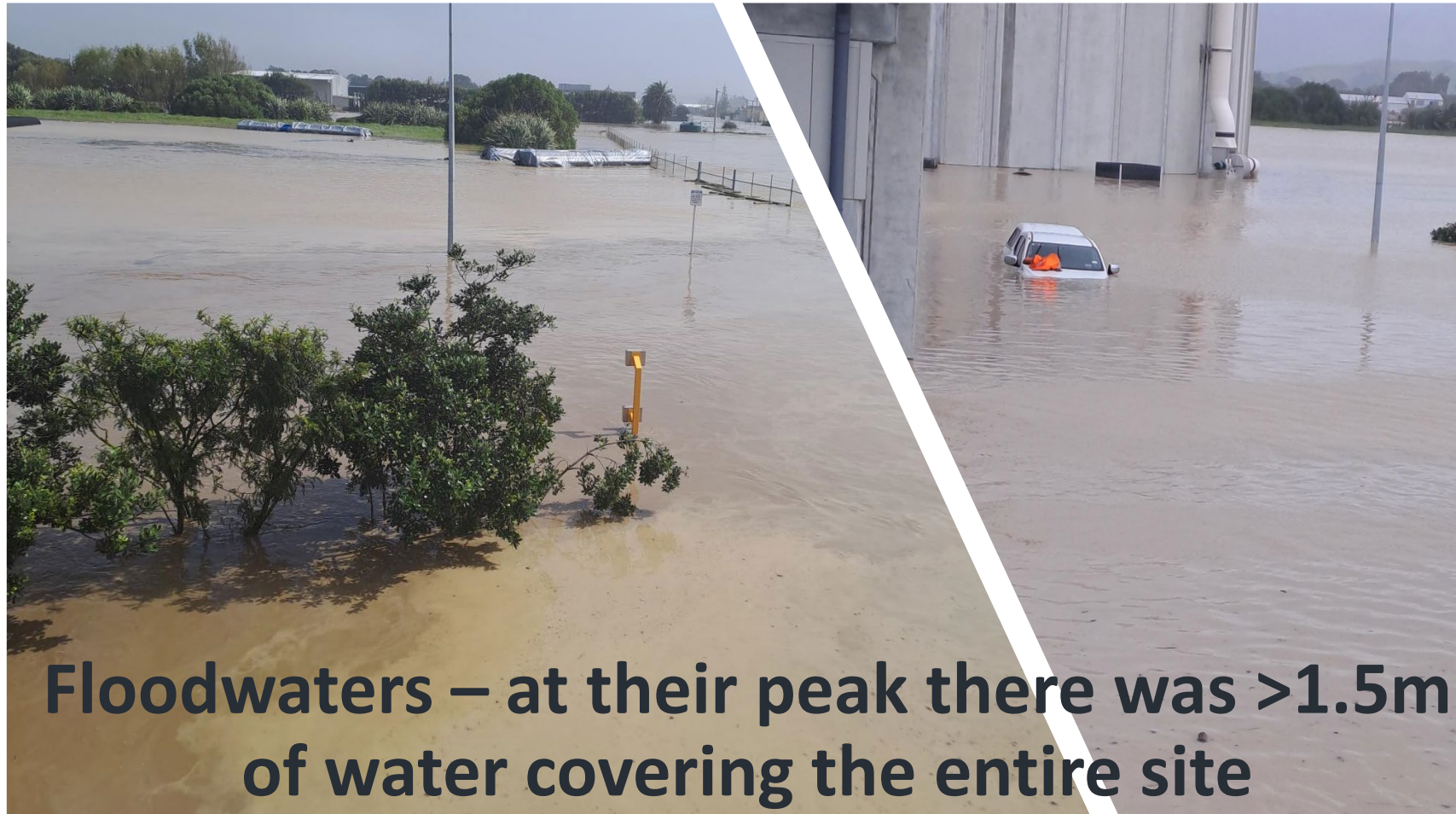

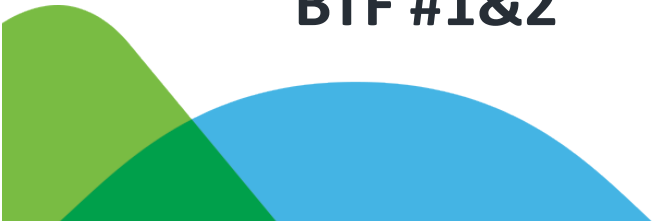

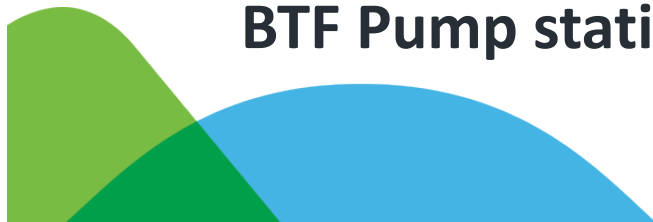
