What is the Social Monitor?

- Annual survey of community wellbeing and perceptions
- A snapshot in time
- Multiple data collection methods
- Representative of Napier
- In field Aug-Sept 2022
- 528 respondents



Community impacts

- National influences such as inflation and cost of living likely to influence quality of life measure at the time of the 2022 Monitor
- Impact of Cyclone Gabrielle is not captured in this survey

➤ Post-Cyclone Gabrielle Wellbeing Survey

- In the field early May – early June
- Reporting July 2023
- Next Social Monitor Aug/Sept 2023



Topline findings - Social Monitor 2022

↑ Feel safe – 62%

↑ Diversity makes Napier a better place to live – 53%

▬ Concerned about climate change impacts – 58%

▬ Napier community could cope after a disaster – 43%

▬ Positive social and neighbourhood connections – 74%

▬ Life in Napier is good – 70%

↓ Quality of life – 30%
