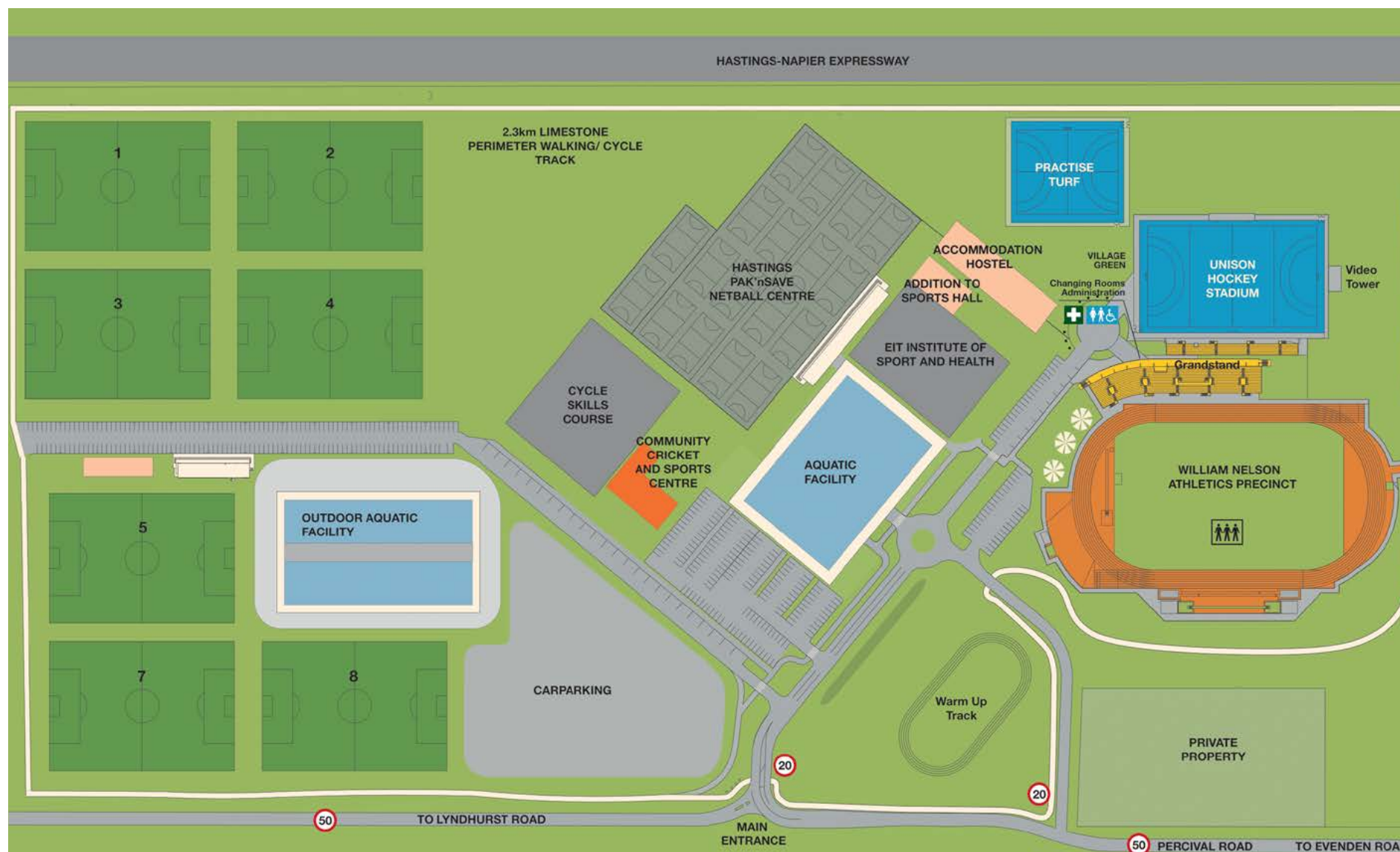

A 2,000sqm cricket and boxing centre is our next major development

cricket

- 4 indoor lanes (supplements 1.5 lanes at Whitmore Park)
- Access for 500 junior players (max capacity 100 players currently)
- Approx 200 of the 500 will be Napier based players
- CD Cricket to be main daytime user
- School and club cricketers to use after hours
- Nets are retractable so Centre is available for other indoor codes

A 2,000sqm cricket and boxing centre is next (ctd)

Boxing

- Centre for Giants Boxing and home to HB Boxing
- Also home to Aikido and Blades Fencing club
- Giants run by former *HB person of the year*, Craig McDougall, and fills a strong social-good function.
- Half of the 150 members are referrals from Youth justice, Police, social workers and school principals
- School opportunity (Taradale, NBHS, William Colenso)

Quote from Saili Fiso. Giants “student”, now coach

\$500k funding gap

Original budget	\$1.40m
Current budget*	\$2.15m
Funds raised	\$1.65m
Funding gap	\$0.50m

Increase a result of original contractor “falling over,” necessary spec increases and Covid related cost increases.

Nevertheless, we have commenced work



Completion Sept 2022, so we have 5 months to close the gap



Our request of Napier

\$100k would be great, but \$50k still meaningful

- Social good that evolves from the Boxing centre
