What is the Social Monitor?

- Annual survey of community wellbeing and perceptions
- A snapshot in time
- Multiple data collection methods
- Representative of Napier
- In field Aug-Sept 2022
- 528 respondents





Community impacts

- National influences such as inflation and cost of living likely to influence quality of life measure at the time of the 2022 Monitor
- Impact of Cyclone Gabrielle is not captured in this survey

➤ Post-Cyclone Gabrielle Wellbeing Survey

- In the field early May early June
- Reporting July 2023
- Next Social Monitor Aug/Sept 2023



Topline findings - Social Monitor 2022

- Feel safe 62%
- 1 Diversity makes Napier a better place to live 53%
- Concerned about climate change impacts 58%
- Napier community could cope after a disaster 43%
- Positive social and neighbourhood connections 74%
- Life in Napier is good 70%
- Quality of life 30%
