## **Management Update for Ngā Mānukanuka o te Iwi Committee 31 January 2025**

The Action points from the 29 August 2024, Ngā Mānukanuka o te Iwi Committee meeting regarding the Cultural Narrative for the Emerson Street upgrade have been completed and the information regarding how rangatahi and Tamariki, specifically rangatahi māori we involved in the consultation and that the adopted principles were reviewed with the Committee to ensure they are embedded in projects has been circulated to the Committee.

Stefni Wilson reported on the Joint Waste Management and Minimisation Plan' to the Ngā Mānukanuka o te Iwi Committee on 29 August 2024 where it was resolved that updates would be provided 'as appropriate'. Here is an update on the progress of that work.

Our joint Waste Teams from Ahuriri Napier City Council and Heretaunga Hastings District Council are happy to share that our joint Waste Assessment (technical document) has been formally adopted by both our parent councils. Napier City Council adopted the joint Assessment on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2024 and Hastings District Council on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2024. During our meetings, the councils approved to give the Joint Waste Futures Project Steering Committee the responsibility and delegation to adopt the final joint Waste Management and Minimisation Plan, after the formal consultation procedure and hearings next year.
