#### 1.1 Purpose of Report

To provide the Napier People and Places Committee with a background report to accompany the minutes of the Arts Advisory Panel meeting held Thursday 13 March 2025.

#### At the meeting

The officer presented the report explaining that both proposals have internal Council approval.

Questions were answered clarifying:

- There is currently no set time frame to determine how long a mural can remain in place, however, the amended Project Proposal form includes a review as part of the acceptance process. The review timeframe would be between two and five years.
- Community groups select their own artists to complete their murals.
- The Project Proposal form is available on Councils' website. The updated form
  provides a robust process to capture all proposals and enables visibility across other
  Council funding schemes.
- There is mana whenua representation on the Arts Advisory Panel to provide advice on cultural components. The Panel will seek additional advice if they are unable to address particular items.
